

AREA FISH

BLUEGILL

Elengtils are popular game fish, caught with both film and itve leat, chiefly at down and deals. They are noted for eaching out underwater regetation for cover. It can be distingainted from similar species by the vertical bars along its flambs. The Bluegill grows to a recallment overall length of approximately 16 is.

LARGEMOUTH BASS

The average Largementh base weight 1 to 2 pounds and is between 3 and 18 inches long. The largest of the black bases, it has mached a maximum recorded overail length of 38 inches and a maximum recorded weight of 22 pounds, 4 evenue. It can live as long as 23 years.

SMALLMOUTH BASS

Smallnowth Base are very papeler game fish, frequently asught by angless using conventional spinning and batt conting gaze, as well as fly fishing tackin. The Smallmooth Base is one of the toughout fighting instructor fish in North America.

NORTHERN PIKE

Northern Pile have very white, wild fiesh, and are considered one of the best testing freekwater fish. When sating piles, be serv to chew carefully, as their "y-bones" are not always easily visible.

TROUT

Trost is the name for a number of species of freehwater fish belonging to the selmon family. Most trost each as Lake trout live in Freehwater lakes and/or rivers asciesively, while there are others such as the rainbery trout which may either live out their lives in freeh water, or spend trea or three years at sea before returning to fresh water to spaws, a habit mare typical of selmon.

MUSKY

Musicy closely resemble for Northern Plice in both appearance and behavior. Like the plice, their bodies are clongated with flat heads and darsel, poivie and anal firs set for back of the boad. Growing to length of 2-6 feet and weighte of over 66 pounds

WALLEYE

Walleyee grow to about 30 inches in length, and weigh up to about 16 lb. Walleyee may live for decedes; the maximum recorded age is 29 years. The mouth of a welleye is large and is anned with many sharp teeth. They are the largest member of the perch family.

YELLOW PERCH

Yellow Parch size our vary greatly between bodies of water, but adults are usually between 4-10 inches in length and weigh about 5.27 az on average. Large Yellow Perch are often called "jumba parch." They are the most frequently caught fish in the state of Michigan.



















Manistique River

The Manistique River begins at the west end of Big Manistique Lake and it flows southwesterly to the town of Manistique, where it empties into Lake Michigan. The river is about 80 miles long and is 2 to 10 feet deep. It flows through mostly state and federal land. Germfask is the only other town on the river. Fishing is primarily for Northern Pike, Walleye and Smallmouth Bass. And while the fishing is excellent, the river also offers outstanding canoeing, kayaking and rafting.



Indian River

The Indian River contains 108 miles of mainstream and tributaries. Much of the 41-mile mainstream offers trophy-size Brook and Brown Trout. 43 lakes and ponds discharge into the Indian River offering a wide variety of fishing opportunities.



Black River

The Black River system is made up of the main stream and two major tributaries; the East Branch of the Black River and Borgstrom Creek, with several smaller tributaries. Borgstrom Creek is primarily a reproductive and nursery area while the East Branch has Brook Trout and yearly runs of Steelhead. Much of the Black River runs through state land, so access is good. You'll find Rainbow, Brown and Brook Trout, Coho Salmon, Mudders and White Suckers.



Tahquamenon River

The mighty Tahquamenon has something for everyone. 11 different species can be found in its waters, including Brook and Brown Trout, Walleye and Musky. In addition to fishing, it's also a great test for the canoeist.



Two-Hearted River


This river system is made up of the mainstream and 5 major tributaries; the South, West, North and East Branches, and Dawson Creek. Brook and Rainbow Trout and Steelhead are the primary fish found in this system.




Fox River



Seney Wildlife Refuge

Sensy National Wildlife Refuge was established in 1935 as a refuge and brancing ground for migratory birds and other wildlife. The wild land that today is the refuge has not always appeared so wild. This is a land that was asso heavily logged, burned, dished, drained and entityated. Despite repeated strempts, the sails and harsh conditions of this country would not provide a hospitable environment for sustained soliteness and agriculture. So, nature claimed it asso again. What was viewed as a loss by early 20th century entrepresents because a hope gain for the wildlife, natural resources and the people of Michigan, and sentem Upper Penintyle.

Soo Locks

The Soo Lodin are a set of parellel ledia which enable ships to travel between Lake Superior and the lower Great Leke. They are located on the St. Marys River between Lake Superior and Lake Hurve, between the Upper Feelbaula of the US state of Michigan and the Canadies province of Ostario. MOREL MUSHROOMS



Yellow Morel / Black Morel

(Morchella escalenta) (Morchella elata)

Cat lengthwise it will be bollow from bottom of stem to top of cap. Will look him a refiber mold, prompting comments from non-morel lowers. The boltom of the cap is alloched to the stem. [Cop and stalk all one piece] The state has little bamps both isside and out. The statk is usually a lighter color. [Sand, yellow or gravish color]. The difference between yellow and black marule is the coloring of the bead



Half-free Morel

(Morchella semilibera)

The half-free morel's cap is unusually small in comparison to the stem and nony only be 1/4th the length of stees. The cap is not connected at the bottom to the stem and only the bottom half of the cap is free. This morel is also entirely hollow. The calor of the half-free range from also at yollow to dark brown.

The more species described here are considered safe to eat. However, if you are not experienced, hust with someone who is or have someone who knows mushroome check them for for you. And always... IF IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT!

Depending on the length and severity of the Upper Perincula winter, morel hunting will useally begin in early to mid-May.

How To Pick a Moral


Try to nover "pull" a morel from the ground! You'll stand a chance of destroying the mycellum that way and you'll only get about 1/4 inch more of the stem anyway. Always "CUT" it off with a small inite (or plach)! Plaching works well with black morels. (Plach, coak the plant a bit, then plach again. Works like a charm with black morels.)

Pinching DOES NOT work very well with yellow morels though. They are measter and stronger. Best to out these. If you pull a morel out with the roots you stand a chance of it never re-growing, as you have just disturbed the mycelium. Anyway, that is the part of the plant system ender the ground that produces the actual morel and is very delicate and easy to bill. So please "OUT"- DON'T PULL

DO NOT east any wild meshroom without properly cooking them fint. Regardless of how you use any wild meshroons, remember cooking is a most [usually 8 to 10 minutes]. Cooking destroys most of the inflante that cause reactions in most people, but not all.


Grand Marais



LIGHTHOUSES & WATERFALLS



Lighthouses and long-distance navigation in Michigan developed together. The excellent transportation system which the Great Lakes provided encouraged their continuous use for shipping and other transportation-related purposes, thus making lighthouses necessary for safe travel.

Lighthouses are an important part of Michigan's history, the first being built between 1818 and 1822. For this reason, many have been renovated into museums.

Out of the 104 lighthouses on Michigan's coastline, over 40 are located along the shorelines of the Upper Peninsula. Many are still operating unmanned, as lighthouses continue to have a very important navigational role on the Great Lakes.

Locate lighthouses with this numbered list found in the Manistique Lakes Area, all just a pleasant drive from Curtis. Not all are open or accessible to the public. Starred lighthouses on the list are, but we recommend calling ahead for hours and dates of operation.

The Upper Tahquamenan Falls is the largest falls in Michigan and the secand largest east of the Mississippi. It is breathtakingly beautiful in all four seasons. The lawer falls is Michigan's secand largest state park. The Tahquamenan River flaws around an island accessible by baat ar canae, where a factpath leads to a series of small waterfalls and beautiful scenery.

OTHER ATTRACTIONS

1. Top of the Lake Snowmobile Museum

The Top of the Lake Snowmobile Museum is an antique & vintage snowmobile museum located in downtown Naubinway. In addition to traditional displays, the museum sponsors the Annual Top of the Lake Swap Meet and the Antique & Vintage Snowmobile Show and Ride.

2. Siphon Bridge

The rebuilt Siphon Bridge is a unique landmark. At one time the bridge was supported by water that was atmospherically forced under it, making it a "floating bridge". Originally built in 1919, it has been featured in Ripley's "Believe It Or Not".

3. Blaney Park


Blaney began as a logging center in 1902 and continued to be lumbered until 1926 when it was converted to a resort. At that time the name was changed to Blaney Park. Though it has seen better days, Blaney Park still holds interest for those in search of interesting area history.

4. Whitefish Point Lighthouse and Museum

Whitefish Point Lighthouse and Museum is the located 10 miles north of Paradise Michigan. It is the oldest active lighthouse on Lake Superior and is located on a corridor known for ship watching, rock collecting and more. The museum features artifacts from shipwrecks, such as the SS Edmund Fitzgerald.

5. Seul Choix Point Lighthouse & Museum

The Seul Choix Pointe Lighthouse (pronounced locally, Sis-Shwa) is located in the town of Gulliver and is operated by the Gulliver Historical Society in cooperation with the Michigan DNR. Representations of all aspects of the area's history have been obtained and are free to view in the Fog Signal building at the Gulliver Historical *Museum*.




Tahquamenon Falls




NORTH MANISTIQUE LAKE

Located just north of Big Manistique Lake Is North Manistique Lake, sometimes referred to as Round Lake. Though it's the smallest of the three lakes, it features the greatest depth with a despest point of 50 fest. Helmer Creek feeds the lake with an entry point on the north share while its outlet feeds into Big Manistique Lake at the southeast corner. The lake bottom is mostly sand with limited growth. The lake can be accessed at the Luce County Park which is just off highway H44. Fish species you'll find include Northern Plice, Small Mouth Base, Walleye, Yellow Perch and Lake Trout.







South Manietique Lake is the southernmost of the three primary area lakes. It can be accessed directly from downtown Curits and any number of private and public access sites. It covers 4,001 acres with an average depth of 10 feet and a maximum depth of 29 feet. It features good vegetation with a lake bottom that is sand, fibrous peat and muck. The lake is fed by several small streams and flows into Portage Creek which empties into Big Manistique Lake.
